Port of Bremerton Hires Cary Bozeman as Chief Executive Officer

Bremerton (WA) – The Port of Bremerton selected Cary Bozeman today as its new Chief Executive Officer. Mr. Bozeman will resign his position as Mayor of the City of Bremerton and will begin his new position as Port CEO on June 8, 2009. Bozeman replaces the previous CEO, Ken Attebery, who retired at the end of 2008.

Port Commission President Cheryl Kincer stated “the intention and goal throughout this hiring process was to create the strongest team possible. I believe in making this selection, together with current Port staff led by Chief Operating Officer, Tim Thomson, we have done just that. I am proud to present this team to the community.”



Bozeman said “I am excited about this new opportunity and the new challenge. I think highly of the Port and will love to be part of this team.”

Bozeman has served as Mayor of the City of Bremerton for over 7 years beginning his first term on January 1, 2002. Prior to serving as Mayor, Bozeman was the Executive Director of the Olympic College Foundation from 1996-2001; President of the Institute for Public Service from 1994-1996, served on the Bellevue City Council from 1976-1993 being elected by the City Council to three terms as Mayor; and was President/CEO of the Boys & Girls Club of King County from 1985-1994.

The Port feels fortunate to have someone with the experience and reputation of Cary Bozeman as their new CEO.
